Request for Mutual Assistance for Norsk Flygerforbund - Norway ALPA

Dear Colleagues,

The Norsk Flygerforbund (NF - Noway ALPA), are requesting Mutual Assistance on behalf of <u>SAS</u> (Scandinavian Airlines System) pilots **based in Norway**.

For the past months, NF has been engaged in negotiations with SAS management in order to renew the Collective Labour Agreement for SAS pilots based in Norway. Negotiations came to a halt last 24 August and thus, both parties agreed to follow a mediation process, starting on 9 September.

As a consequence of this, if the mediation process is not successful, industrial action in form of a strike will be taken by <u>SAS pilots based in Norway</u>, on **11 September** at **00:01 LT**, until further notice.
