## Request for Mutual Assistance for ACDAC Colombia

Dear Colleagues,

The Asociación Colombiana de Aviadores Civiles – ACDAC (Colombia ALPA), are requesting Mutual Assistance on behalf of AVIANCA pilots.

ACDAC has been actively engaged in negotiations with AVIANCA management with the intention of making the company compliant with the current aviation legislation and several court rulings that are not being respected. Likewise, to enforce the current Collective Labour Agreement, and to improve the Flight/Duty Time Limitations and safety regulations in order reduce fatigue issues amongst pilots. In addition to this, to definitely stop all kinds of harassment and discrimination from the AVIANCA management towards ACDAC affiliated pilots.

As a consequence of this, ACDAC's General Assembly decided to take **industrial action in form of a strike** starting on Wednesday **20 September at 4:00 am LT, until further notice.**
