



Captain John J. Malone

Captain Malone began his career as a US Naval Officer. He served in active duty from 1981-88, and as a Drilling Reservist from 1988-91. While in the Navy, he flew C-2A and T-2C aircraft.

His commercial aviation career started at Delta, as Second Officer on the B-727 from 1988-89. He flew the MD-88 from 1989-2005, beginning as First Officer and moving up to Captain in 1997. Still a Captain at Delta, Captain Malone has been flying the B-767 and B-757 since 2005.

Throughout his career, Captain Malone has held a variety of union positions, including Membership Committee Chairman for both Council 047 from 1992-1994 and the Delta MEC from 1993-1995. From 1995-1997, he was DFW First Officer Representative to the Delta MEC, and Member of the Delta MEC Negotiating Committee from 1997-1998.

From 1998-2002, Captain Malone was Chairman of the Delta MEC Negotiating Committee, and also Chairman of the Delta MEC Code Sharing Committee in 2003. Captain Malone has been Chairman of the Delta MEC twice, first from 2003-2005 and then from 2015-2016.
